

Clerk's report

Mattishall Parish Council

September 2022

1. Following from our last meeting an email was sent to District Councillor Paul Claussen to ask if he can assist us in locating where we can order / purchase a replacement village map. Waiting for a response from Cllr Paul Claussen.
2. The clerk had reported that we had various Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) within the village of Mattishall. All incidents have been reported to PC Clarke and Aimee Foster, the ASB officer of Breckland District Council (BDC) and reported using the online police portal. Mattishall Parish Council has made arrangements inviting PC Clarke, Aimee Foster and all residents to attend a meeting which will be held on 5th September at Poultec Business Park starting from 6pm to raise any ASB issues and any other concerns.
3. The clerk reported that BDC do offer funding up to 12.5p per mile towards the Community Car scheme. The clerk had emailed the organisation and shared the information received from BDC. If they were to apply for this funding this could reduce the passenger fee to 20p per mile as opposed to the 33p per mile currently charged.
4. Mansfield fencing has collected the Platinum Jubilee bench and the time capsule is complete and sealed. Mansfield fencing will install the bench in the next few weeks after some rain to enable the ground to be softer for installation. I have visited the resident opposite to explain, they are happy and have no concerns.
5. The church gate opposite the fish and chip shop has been damaged. The handyman has confirmed that the gate is rotten and needs repair. I have received confirmation from the Church that the gate is our responsibility. They have also confirmed that no faculty is required if it is a straightforward replacement.
