

## Mattishall Parish Council

Charges associated with burial and interment of ashes at Burgh Lane Cemetery  
with effect from 6 January 2022

### Interment Fees

Of a coffin burial in a double depth grave of a person (resident or non-resident) exceeding 16 years old	£300
Of a child exceeding 6 years but not exceeding 16 years old	£150
Of an infant under 6 years old	No charge
Interment of cremated remains (residents or non- residents)	£100
Interment of cremated remains (resident or non-resident) in a family grave/Memorial Garden	£50

### Exclusive Right of Burial (Including Deed of Grant)\*

Grant of exclusive right of burial in the Cemetery (residents and non-residents) for period not exceeding 99 years	£175
Grant of exclusive right of burial in the Memorial Garden (residents and non-residents) for period not exceeding 99 years	£85

### Memorial Fees

Erection of a headstone	£160
Any additional inscription	No charge
For the organisation and installation of a cast bronze memorial plaque in black with bronze writing, including inscription	£170

\*Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial gives the owner right of burial in a grave for a period specified by the Council which is currently 99 years. Ownership of an Exclusive Right of Burial does not imply ownership of the land itself which remains with the Council.

Deed of Grant (for an Exclusive Right of Burial) is an important legal document that confirms you are the current owner of the grave and this should be stored in a safe place.

A headstone cannot be erected until a Grant of Exclusive Right has been purchased.

Fees were agreed at a meeting of the Parish Council held on 6 January 2020. The Parish Council is no longer taking reservations in the Cemetery.
